### Death of Archbishop O'Connor of Toronto.

Toronto, June 30—Archbishop O'Connor died this morning shortly after five o'clock, at St. Basil's Novitiate. He had been sick for the past three years from Bright's disease, and his end was expected at any time. Archbishop O'Connor came to Toronto from London, when Archbishop Walsh died, and he was Archbishop until the late Archbishop McEvay was appointed in 1908. He retired because of ill health, and was named Archbishop of Laodicea.

Archbishop O'Connor was born at Pickering, Ont., on March 28, 1841, was ordained priest on December 8, 1863, became bishop of London, Ont., on October 19, 1890 and was made Archbishop of Toronto on January 24, 1899.
