### DE VALERA USED AIRSHIP TO GET TO IRISH ISLE

Secretary Says: Best Accomplishment in Formation of International Justice Court.

### SOME THINGS IT HAS INAUGURATED

Outlines Many Things That Must Be Solved Yet by the League.

Paris, Jan. 10.—The secretary of the League of Nations today issued an official document entitled "The Work Accomplished by the League of Nations." During the first year of its existence, Jan. 10, 1920, to Jan. 10, 1921, commencing the various questions settled or discussed by the League.

It mentions first the establishment of a permanent international court of justice; second, the work accomplished in the limitation of armaments; and, third, the creation of an international commission to study use of the blockade as an economic weapon.

### Political Constitution.

Under the heading, "Efforts at political constitution," the document refers to the question of the island islands, upon which the League commission will report within three weeks.

As measures designed to remedy the economic crisis, the report says, the creation of an economic and financial commission in accordance with the conclusions of the Brussels financial conference and the organization of a transit commission were foremost in the League's work.

Respecting execution of the peace treaty, the League points out the following missions accomplished: 1. Administration of the Saar Valley; 2. Direction of the affairs of the free city of Danzig; 3. Rejection of the German government's conclusions and note asking further guarantees in Danzig and Memel; and the final awarding of the territory to Belgium; 4. The establishment of a permanent mandate commission to administer the affairs of former German colonies; 5. Acceptance of responsibility for the protection of minorities; 6. The registering of 69 treaties in accordance with the stipulations of the treaty of Versailles.

### Typist "Too Cute To Shoot"—But She Did And Employer Dead

Dallas, Texas, Jan. 10.—William J. Coleman, restaurant proprietor, whose death has been a mystery for ten days, lost his life at the hands of a girl he believed "too cute to shoot," according to a confession the police said Miss Louise Merier, 16 years of age, a typist, made today.

Miss Merier, who was arrested at Crossbuck yesterday, said she fired the shot that caused Coleman's death in the abdomen on the night of January 1. He died without regaining consciousness.

Invited to Park. Miss Merier in her alleged statement said that on New Year's evening she accepted Coleman's invitation to visit a party of friends camped in the park. Arriving at the park, the girl's statement says she felt uneasy, deserted, and started to leave, whereupon Coleman was alleged to have detained her. "I told him to turn me loose or I would shoot," she said. Chief Gunning quoted the girl as saying: "He said I was too cute to shoot, so I pulled the pistol and shot him."

### DE VALERA USED AIRSHIP TO GET TO IRISH ISLE

Dropped from Ocean Liner When off Coast Where Motor Boat Awaited.

### GUARDS ON SHORE WERE LURED AWAY

Their Aircraft Picked Him up and Took Him to Unknown Destination.

New York, Jan. 10.—President Eamon De Valera of the Republic of Ireland used at least two boats and a seaplane on his trip to Ireland, according to disclosures.

It is declared that he departed from this country either on December 31 or January 1, being picked up outside of territorial waters by a yacht which had made the trip from Ireland for the purpose of transporting him home.

On the afternoon of December 29 his yacht was met by a seaplane at a point about twenty miles out from the Atlantic coast of the United States. De Valera and his party embarked from the coast of County Clare. After some trouble with engine of the seaplane the Irish president was landed on Meaton Island near dusk, tired and hungry. He was given temporary assistance in the shape of bread and water.

Lured Guards Away. Communication through established channels was maintained with the main land and shortly before dawn word came that the British guards had been lured from the vicinity.

De Valera and his party embarked in small boats and made for the mainland. He went to the home of a loyal friend near Kilmurry where he remained all day December 30. In the early hours of that day while he rested, the word was flashed back to America to release the message of his landing in safety.

At one time on the trip across the yacht was challenged by a British captain, but the captain of the yacht persuaded the Britisher that his was a pleasure yacht on a cruise.

Since landing De Valera has moved nearly every night, always travelling with a sufficient guard of the Irish publican army to insure his safety from capture by any ordinary detachment of the military.
