# **BLACKLISTS FOR** DRUNKARDS WILL BE QUEBEC LAWS

Drastic and Severe Changes Proposed in New Measure to be Enacted.

JAIL WITHOUT OPTION OF FINE IS LIKELY

Breweries Shipping Beer Into the Province Will Have to Pay Big License.

Quebec, Jan. 31.—The provincial cabinat has, it is understood, agreed on the original features of the liquor control buil, waitch is to be submitted to the legislature this week.

In regard to the sale of the liquor at the retail government shops to the consumer, there will not be a permit system, such as is being suggested in British Columbia, but there will be an effective system of "black list" in every shop. Those who are condemned for drunkenness will get on that list; those whose mothers, fathers or wives complain that their male folks are drinking too much will get on that list, and the commission will devise such a system of checking up that it will be difficult to best such a list, especially in small places.

Penalties provided in the new law are so severe that only the most fool-hardy will undertake to defeat some clauses of the law. Jail sentences without option are provided for violation or some clauses, even for the first offence, and provision is made in the bill, by cleverly drawn clauses to prevent technicalities defeating the purposes of the penalty clauses.

It is understood that the bill will provide a measure of protection for brewers in this province by the imposition of a tax of one thousand dolars on breweries outside of the province which ship beer into Quebec.

This would affect chiefly brewers in Great Britain. The province of Quete of course, cannot levy taxes on persons or companies outside its own boundaries, out this difficulty is overcome by making the tax apply on the wholesaie agents in Quebec of such outside breweries. This government recognizes the protection of home industries, in addition to the matter of revenue. Brewers in the province pay a substantial tax on all they brew, namely two and a nulf per cent and this is to be rated, consequently there is no good reason why outside browers should not pay.

Another of the powers which the commission will have will be that of ranting a hotel a permit to sell wine and beer after 9 o'clock in the case of
