ROCKS LARGE AS SHIPS HURLED BY VOLCANO

Smoke Cloud from Kamichitka Eruption Extends Hundred Miles.

Tokio, Nov. 21.—Showers of rocks larger than ships were hurled from a raging volcano on Kamichitka, where a terrible and magnificent phenomenon occurred in August, recalling the primitive days of the formation of the earth.

In a report to the Japan Advertiser Mr. McCormick says: "On arriving at Hakodate, in northern Japan, I heard from a fisherman of an earthquake above Hokkaido and the appearance in the sea September 5 of a part of the island of the Kurile group."

"The eruption extended from Hokkaido to the Aleutians and was but a prolongation of the seismic phenomena occurring in Kamachitka, where I was wrecked on the Kronotskiy Peninsula.
