ORPHANS' HOMEAnnual Meeting of the Sub-  
scribers Held in the Mayor's  
Office at Noon Yesterday.

The annual meeting of the subscribers to the Protestant Orphans' Home was held at noon yesterday in Mayor Frank's office. Reports were submitted as follows:

The directors' report shows, May 8th, 1911, the fifty-seventh year of the institution. Since the last report, the year opened with thirty-three children in the home, ten have since been admitted and twelve placed out, leaving at present in the home thirty-three children—twenty girls and thirteen boys.

With the exception of a number of cases of whooping cough during the spring months, the general health of the children has been good. Dr. Inches has continued to render gratuitous medical services throughout the year, and has given by members of the Y. M. C. A. The corporation has received two requests during the year for the use of the late Miss M. J. Hay, Greenfield, N. S., \$80; estate Edwin J. Everett, \$500. The death of the late John M. Irvine has removed one who for many years was a director and an active worker in the interests of the institution.

The personal subscriptions for the year amounted to \$1,763.81. The directors wish to thank those who have so kindly contributed toward the needs of the home. The treasurer's report, duly audited, is submitted herewith.

Ladies' Committee.

The report of the ladies' committee for the year ending April 30, follows:

We report at present thirty-seven children in the Home—twenty-four girls and thirteen boys. In December there were several cases of whooping cough, and in March a girl being very ill. Through the efficient care of our matron, however, all are rapidly recovering. Dr. Inches kindly attended, as in the past. There were the usual outings to the parks and beaches during the summer months. In July Mr. Macdonald's annual picnic was as usual greatly enjoyed. Through the kindness of several of our citizens who loaned their cars, the children were given a drive through the city and suburbs, which was a great treat.

All the members of the home were invited to attend the provincial exhibition. The Excelsior Band of the Queen Square Methodist church entertained all the girls at tea, giving each one a doll and a bag of candy. They also sent oranges to the boys. The primary class of the German street church sent eggs for Easter. Several young men from the Y. M. C. A. have instructed the boys in physical exercises. The summer and winter school examinations were conducted as usual. By the death of J. E. Irvine, the home has lost a kind and generous friend. Mr. Irvine was for many years a member of the board, and after leaving the city never failed to remember the orphans each year. Mrs. D. Hutchinson, Miss Green, Mr. Irvine and Mrs. M. A. Sheffield have been added to the committee.

We heartily thank all who have kindly contributed during the past year.
