

DONALD, JOSEPH. [*Charlotte.*]

B. in Cumberland, Eng., 1807. Ed. there. M., 1829, the Grand-d. of Capt. Mathew Thornton, an old loyalist. Followed the profession of a mariner for 14 years. Unsuccessfully contested Charlotte, upon four occasions. First returned at last g. e. — *Red Pine Grove, St Stephen.*

GILLESPIE, THOMAS F. [*Northumberland.*]

B. near Mallow, Cork, Irel., 15 Dec., 1828. Ed. at Rathkeal. M., Elizabeth, eld. dau. of Alex. Cormack, Esq., of Chatham. Is Proprietor of the Chatham Iron Foundry. Capt. Chatham Battery Garrison Artillery. An unsuccessful candidate for present seat in Commons at g. e. 1867, for Local, same year, and again, 1869. First returned at last g. e. — *Chatham.*

GIBOUARD, ANTOINE, J. P. [*Kent.*]

Of French Acadian family. B. in Buctouche, N. B., 25 Apl, 1836. Ed. there. M., May, 1856, Miss Isabella Casey. Has held various County offices. First returned to Parlt. at last g. e. for present seat. — *St. Marys, N. B.*

GOUGH, JACOB C. [*Northumberland.*]

Unsuccessfully contested Northumberland for Commons, 1868. First returned to Parlt. 1867, for present seat. Re-elected at last g. e. — *Chatham.*

HARRISON, ARCHIBALD. [*Sunbury.*]

S. of the Hon. C. Harrison, M. L. C. Unsuccessfully contested present seat, 1868. First returned at last g. e. — *Upper Maudersville.*

HATHEWAY, Hon. GEORGE LUTHER. [*York.*]

Paternal grandf. a loyalist. B. 4 August, 1813. Ed. in St. John. M., June, 1840, Miss Martha Slason. Was a mem. of Ex. Council,
