BILL.

An Act to exempt Firemen in Cities, from the payment of any Statute Labor Tax.

BE it enacted, &c.

That when any member of any Company of Firemen Firemen which is or may be regularly enrolled in any City of this having served Province, wherein the formation of Companies of Fire-a certain time exempt from 5 men is by law authorized and regulated, has regularly and Road Lobour faithfully served for the space and term of seven years and from consecutively in the same, the said member shall be entitled to receive, upon producing due proof of his having served seven years consecutively as aforesaid, a certifiin cate from the Clerk of the Common Council of the City in which he resides, or the Clerk of the Corporate Body under whose authority the said Company shall have been established, that he has been regularly enrolled and served as a member of the said Fire Company for the space of is seven years, which certificate shall exempt the individual named therein from the payment of any Personal Statute Labor Tax thereafter, and from serving as a Juror on the trial of any canse in any Court of Law within this Province; any law, custom or usage to the contrary not-90 withstanding.
