the said River to the southerly bounds of the Province, and on the north-east by part of the River and Gulf of St. Lawrence, comprehending the Inferior District and County of Gaspé as herein-above described, and all the Territory lying north-castward of the said boundary line, to be comprised within the District of Quebec, and such part of the said District of Quebec as lies on the north side of the River St. Lawrence, shall be bounded by a line commencing on the north bank of the said River, being the division line between the Seigniories of St. Anne and Grondines, as heretofore established, running from thence north-west along said division line to the depth of the said Seigniories of St. Anne and Grondines, thence continuing on the same course to the north-west boundary of the Province, comprising within the said District of Quebec all the Territory north-east of the said line to the casternmost boundary of the said Province, on the North Shore of the River and Gulf St. Lawrence, and the said District of Quebcc shall comprehend all the Islands in the said River St. Lawrence, within the north-eastern and south-western boundaries or limits of the said District, including the Magdalene Islands and the Islands appertaining as above-mentioned to the said County of Gaspe. such part of the District of Montreal as lies on the south side of the said River St. Lawrence, shall be bounded on the north-east by a line to commence near the River St. Lawrence, at the Bay Lavallière, in rear of the tongue of land commonly called the Concession of the Chenail du Moine, at the south-westerly boundary line of the Seigniory of Yamaska; which said tongue of land is hereby included in the said District of Montreal, running from thence along the said boundary line, which divides the said Seigniory from the Seigniory of Sorel, south-eastward, to the depth of the said Seigniory of Sorel; thence continuing on the same course between the Seigniories of Bonsecours and Yamaska or Lavallière, to the River Yamaska; thence, up the middle of the said River, to the north-cast lateral line of the Seigniory of St. Charles, being the division line between the Seigniorics of Bourgmarie east, and St. Charles; thence along the said line between the said Seigniorics of Bourgmarie east, and St. Charles, to the depth of the said Seigniories; thence continuing on the same course between the Seigniory of De Ramzay and Township of Upton, to the easterly angle of the said Segni-ory of De Ramzay; thence, eastward, along the northerly bounds of lot No. 40, in the 21st range of the said Township of Upton, to the north-westerly angle of the Township of Acton; thence continuing on the same course to the southernmost angle of the Township of Grant-
