**FISSET NOMINATED  
FOR RIMOUSKI SEAT**

**Ex-Deputy Minister Wins On 3  
To 2 Vote.**

RIMOUSKI, Que., July 31.—Brig-Gen. Sir Eugene Fiset was nominated Liberal candidate for the forthcoming federal byelection at Rimouski here, this afternoon.

Auguste Cote, prothonotary of Rimouski, was also named, but was defeated by a three-to-two vote of the delegates present.

Hon. Ernest Lapointe, Minister of Justice, presided at the meeting, and briefly addressed the delegates.
