Ottawa, 30th March, 1908.

Sir,-

With further reference to your accounts for travelling expenses, I beg to point out in connection with the account for April that the diary is incomplete as the 13th, 14th, 15th, 17th and 18th are omitted therefrom. It appears that you went from Beausejour to Winnipeg to enter the hospital at St. Boniface and therefore the hotel accounts on that occasion, viz:- \$4.50 in April (receipt No. 1) and \$7.50 in May (receipt No. 1) when you left the hospital cannot be allowed.

In the June account a charge of \$1.00 is made on the 4th but the service is not stated.

Receipt No. 5 in the September account is returned herewith as it is unsigned.

There is an error in the addition of the October account. It should be \$24.21 instead of \$25.90.

You should explain why you do not procure return tickets from Selkirk to Winnipeg. Do they not issue return tickets between these points?
