Gentlemen:-

I beg to say that Messrs. Lymans Limited of Montreal have been requested to supply certain drugs for use at the Indian School at Rupert's House, James Bay. They have been told to address these drugs to the Church of England Missionary in charge, Rupert's House, James Bay and to deliver them to you before the 15th of the present month, and it is desired that you will kindly send forward the package containing the drugs when your boat goes north.

I may add that Burroughs Welcome of Montreal have also been requested to supply certain articles, viz., tabloid bandages and they have been told to make delivery of the same to you. Kindly give each firm a receipt for the articles delivered. It is desired to have the goods furnished by Burroughs Welcome as well as those supplied by Lymans Limited shipped to the Church of England Missionary, Rupert's House, James Bay.
