Sir,

I beg to say that the Department has received your letter of the 15th July, and the statement of freight charges dated 13th July to the amount of \$111.33 which you submitted in connection with drugs shipped on behalf of Indians to different points in British Columbia. The charges shown in the statement in question appear to be for freight on the drugs supplied, and I beg to point out that the respective freight charges should have appeared in every case in the account for the drugs. I may add that accounts for drugs cannot be paid until the receipts for payments of freight made are submitted to the Department in support of the charges.
