

Every Baker to stamp each Loaf or Biscuit with the initials of his name, and upon condition of any offence against these regulations, shall forfeit and pay a sum not less than Ten Shillings, nor more than Forty Shillings for each offence. An entry shall be made from time to time, by the Clerk of the Market, in a Book to be kept for that purpose, of the Assize of Bread, as fixed each month, or oftener if required, which Book, any inhabitant may inspect at all reasonable hours, without fee.— The Clerk of the Market, likewise, to keep an account of the Prices of Flour, to lay before the Magistrates when called for.

SLAUGHTER-HOUSES, &c.

No Slaughter-House to be erected, or made use of, within the limits of the Town, without the owner or occupier thereof having previously obtained especial permission for that purpose, from the Magistrates in Session, under a penalty of Forty Shillings for each offence. No chips, shavings, or rubbish, of any description, to be thrown into the Street, or in the front of the Town, under a penalty of not less than Ten Shillings, nor more than Forty, for each offence.
