

ECLIPSES FOR THE YEAR 1810.

The Eclipses are both of the Sun :

THE first, April 3d, at 9h. 22m. P. M. invisible. The longitude of the ☉ and ♄ 13°, 38, lat. of the Moon 6° N. The Sun will be centrally eclipsed on the meridian, in longitude 154° 40' East and latitude 11°, 20" North.

The Second—September 28th, at 32 minutes afternoon, in long. 4° 52' Moon's lat. 3° 50" South invisible. The Sun will be centrally eclipsed on the meridian, in longitude 72° 20' West, and latitude 6° South.
