And they went to the conference,

Mr. Tonge moved that the House do now adjourn, which, being seconded and put, passed in the negative.

Mr. James moved that the House do now resolve itself into a Committee of Supply, which, being seconded and put, passed in the assirmative, and thereupon,

The House resolved itself into a Committee of Supply accordingly.

Mr. Speaker left the Chair.

Mr. James took the Chair.

Mr. Speaker refumed the Chair.

The Chairman reported from the Committee, that they had gone through the business to them referred; and had come to a Resolution thereupon, which the Committee had directed him to report to the House, and he afterwards delivered the same in at the Clerk's Table, where it was read and is as follows:

Refolved, That it is the opinion of this Committee, that the fun of feven pounds should be granted to the Door Keeper of His Majesty's Council, for his attendance during the present Session.

The faid Resolution was read throughout a first and second time, and, upon the question put thereupon, agreed to by the House.

Ordered, that the Clerk do carry the foregoing resolution to the Council and desire their concurrence to the same.

On motion, refolved, that the Clerk do request a further conference with the Council by Committee on the subject matter of the last conference.
