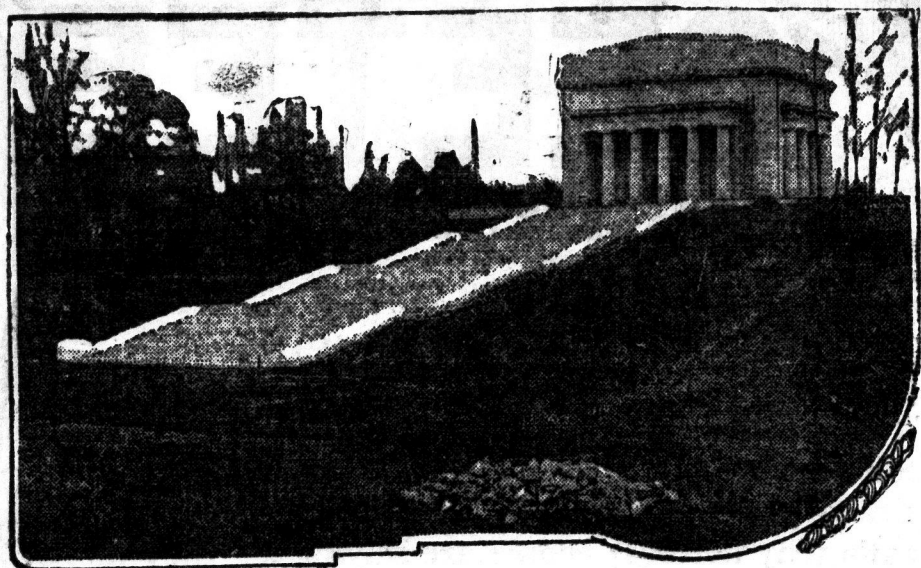


Home Honor to the Greatest American--Statue and Memorial to Lincoln in Kentucky

This statue of Lincoln bears the inscription: "Two miles south of this town, Abraham Lincoln was born, Feb. 12, 1809. Erected with the appropriation made by the Legislature of Kentucky and the Congress of the United States Anno Domini MCXIX." The statue has just been unveiled.

This statue was created for the courthouse square of Hodgenville, Ky., Lincoln's native town. It was placed in as unobtrusive as possible and unobtrusive as possible as could be.

THE DEVELOPMENT OF MOVING PICTURES

The development of the motion picture from the crude eye-blinding spectacle of 1896 to the finished photograph of today is a wonder equalled only by the rapidity with which the moving picture sprang into popular favor and enjoyment in all parts of the world.

The first moving pictures to be widely exhibited in the United States left a trail of aching eyes and frayed nerves from the Atlantic to the Pacific. The pictures jumped, flickered, and did almost everything possible to make the spectator close his eyes in self-defence. But they moved! That was the wonder, and the people risked headache to see them move.

Now, after the lapse of less than fifteen years, one may sit before the moving picture screen and see there all the world—real and mimic. He may see Madame Sarah Bernhardt, the foremost actress of the time, playing Camille as a photo-play; he may see the newly-crowned George V. receiving the homage of his people; he may see the birdmen cleaving the air; ships at sea; wild beasts in their jungle; children at play; men at work; plants growing and flowers blooming; and a thousand and one wonders in the moving picture. And, if they are of the best, the pictures do not jump, nor flicker, nor flash.

In the beginning, the success of a moving picture depended almost wholly upon the quality of motion. The simple fact that pictures throw upon a screen by a stereoscopic camera, and were taken of groups of people walking on the street, or of a factory at the end of the day's work, or of trains rushing by stations, and, in short, of all kinds of commonplace, everyday incidents, attracted the public in large theatres, soon became a regular end of the program of the vaudeville and stock company theatres.

The public quickly grew tired of the commonplace street scenes and partly in response to popular demand and partly because of the increasing competition between the several motion picture concerns, the photo-play, or dramatic exhibition specially posed for the moving picture camera was evolved. Still, having in mind the psychological appeal of violent motion in pictures, the first crude photo-plays nearly all were "chase pictures." The plot might be anything, but it only introduced a chase. A fleeing thief, pursued by two or three policemen, and a motley collection of "citizens" was a feature of almost every film.

About the same time the possibilities of the moving picture as an instrument of instruction began to be realized, and travel pictures came to vogue. Motion still being regarded as an essential, the camera man mounted moving trains, and as a result, the patrons of the theatre were whirled backward and forward through miles and miles of scenery, little attention being made at selection or diversification.

But still the moving picture had not attained its own. At best it was but the last vaudeville stunt on a programme in a cheap theatre, and the claim to be of the people's amusement was a claim to be of the people's amusement. Then came the "nickelodeon." found in the south. The prominent women of Hodgenville, realizing that the contribution to their town of such a great work of art by state and national appropriation should have an appropriate setting, organized themselves into the Ladies' Lincoln League for the purpose of parking the town square. Robert T. Lincoln sent them a check for \$1,000 to assist them in their work. They have not only parked the town square and made attractive that which was once ugly, but they have stimulated a civic pride in the little town and converted a ragged little village into a modern spick-span, neat little city.

Down in the south, on the Chesapeake, near Crisfield, Mr. Lavallette owns a terrapin farm, which covers several acres, and on which he has a large number of terrapins, ranging in size from that of a ten-cent silver piece, to the "bustard" terrapin, which are worth as much as \$100 a dozen. Nothing has been offered to good feeders which can take the place of terrapin and champagne, and Mr. Lavallette has never experienced trouble in selling the output of his farm.

These toothsome birds are getting scarcer every day, until now large ones are worth their weight in silver. Less than seventy-five years ago Maryland had to enact a law prohibiting slave owners from feeding slaves with terrapin most often twice a week, as the food was too rich and produced disease. At that time terrapin sold for as little as 50 cents for a wagon load. Washington and Lafayette entered a protest at being fed on terrapin at Yorktown. There are other terrapin farms on the Chesapeake but Mr. Lavallette's is the largest in the United States.

In the same section, too, there are a number of crab farms, and the crab farmers can match dollars with any class of small farmers in the country. The crab season is a short one, and it is easy money for hundreds of persons on the "eastern shore." The first shipment of any importance from the Chesapeake crab farms was in 1887, when the output was valued at \$84,000, but it will now reach \$650,000, with 8,000 farmers and 4,000 boats.

Should the secret service agent and his associates find a friend, finds Ivan Turgenev, the grocer, a formidable trade competitor, it will so come to pass that the secret service agent becomes richer by the day, and the account of information embodied in accompanying memorandum, Ivan is packed off to the nearest city jail pending the dispatch of a political to Yakutsk. He cannot defend himself. Against what charges could he defend himself? He is confronted with no imputation that might be dismissed by an alibi or the production of witnesses.

The secret service system of Holy Russia today is one gigantic system of graft and bribery which cannot be justified by the few exceptions which go to prove the rule. The olden Vehmgericht and the Grand Inquisitor, by many malefactors, were at least imbued with a genuine, if narrow and crude, sense of world judgment and spiritual right. These days, however, the secret service is a grim background of Czar Nicholas' twentieth century detective force.

Frog farming is an enterprise carried on by the American girl of today.

Miss Isabelle Morgan is a pioneer in this line. Before taking up the occupation of farming she was a stenographer in Baltimore. The strict business training then gained she considered the basis of her success. When the strain of office hours told on Miss Morgan's health, her physicians ordered her into the open air, and she returned to her home on a farm, which her father had bought with a large interest in such a situation difficult.

In looking back Miss Morgan considers it the most fortunate incident of her career, for she embarked in her present business.

Here he spends his time buried in the mud and moss except at night, when he comes out to feed upon the insects and other delicacies that make up the young frog's menu.

The frogs Miss Morgan sells for eating purposes have the legs skinned and shaped by his water. The choice specimens destined for laboratory use are first selected.
