Sherlock-Manning Piano Co.

One of First to Adopt Modern Protec-
tion Plan.

One of the greatest sources of labor
unrest is claimed to be a haunting fear
of the future, a dread of leaving de-
pendents unprotected. Under a new
system recently devised by leading in-
surance authorities of this continent,
policies of what is called Group Insurance
are now being effected and are
proving most effective in banishing the
spectre of future want and privation
from the minds of working men and
women.

A new policy covers the entire
working force of a plant, from the low-
est employee to the highest, and the
firm pays one annual premium which
protects all. One of the first to adopt
this advanced liberal treatment of its
employees in London is the Sherlock-
Manning Piano Company, which is
presenting to each of its workers cer-
tificates of insurance, the premiums on
which will be paid each year by the
firm. Workers who have been with the
company over one year and under two

"THE LUCK OF THE NAVY"

Coming to Grand Christmas
Day, Friday and
Saturday.

Speaking of the eminent English
actor, Percy Hutchinson's production of
"The Luck of the Navy," which he
brings to the Grand for three nights
and two matinees, commencing Christ-
