

REVIEW OF HISTORICAL PUBLICATIONS RELATING TO CANADA. *Toronto: William Briggs, 1899. Royal 8vo., IX-225 p.*

This volume, the third of the series, of Historical publications relating to Canada for the year 1898, edited by Mr. Geo. M. Wrong, M. A., professor of his history in the University of Toronto, and Mr. H. H. Langton, B. A., librarian of the same university, is particularly interesting and contains a most complete bibliography of historical writings relating to Canada, published in Canada, United States and Europe.
