

WAFFLES. - Three cupsful of milk, one great spoonful of butter, one egg, three cupsful of flour, one teaspoonful of soda and two teaspoonsful of cream of tartar. If you use sour milk omit the cream of tartar.

RYB GEMS -Three cupsful of tye meal, two cupsful of flur, two and one-quarter cupsful of sweet misk, one spoonful of salt, one egg, one tea-spoonful of salt, one egg, one tea-spoonful of cream of tartar and one half teaspoonful of soda. BREAKPAST CAKES .- One and a half cups of Indian meal, one and a half cups of flower, half a cup of sugar, butter, a teaspoonful of soda, milk, one egg; stir cream of tartar in the flour and dissolve the soda in a little cold water; mix all this quite soft with milk; bake in shallow pans. To be eaten hot with butter.

SPONGE PUDDING.—One egg, one cupiul of sugar, a small piece of butter, one half cupiul of water or sweet milk, two teaspoonsful of baking powder, and flour enough to make a good batter. Bake in a long tin pan in a quick oven.

CHOCOLATE CAKE. - Simple - One cup sugar, one half-cup butter, one cup sweet milk, two and one-half cups flour, two teaspoons baking powder, the yelks of five eggs and the whites of two. Bake in jelly pans. For icing, spread between the layers whites of three eggs, thicken with powdered sugar and one cake of grated sweet chocolate.

FRIED BOILED EGGS .- Slice hardboiled eggs, dip in breadcrumbs and raw egg, and f.y in butter; serve hot. This is a good plan of serving eggs that have been left at breakfast.

RYE MUFFINS. - One cup sifted tye meal, one cup white flower, one-fourth sugar, one-half teaspoon salt, two teaspoons haking powder, one egg, one cup milk. Mix the dry ingredients thoroughly; beat the egg, add the milk, and stir quickly into the dry mixture. Bake in hot gem pans twentyfive minutes.





