Notice to Contractors.

SEALED TENDERS, addressed to the under signed and endorsed "Tender for the St. Lawrence Canals," will be received at this office until the arrival of the eastern and western mails on TUESDAY, the 30th day of October instant, for the construction of two locks and the deepening and enlargement of the upper entrance of the Gallops Canal.

A map of the locality, together with plans and specifications will be ready for examination at this office and at the Lock-keeper's house, Gallops, on and after THURSDAY, the 16th day of October instant, where forms of tender may be obtained by Contractors on personal application.

In the case of firms there must be attached the actual signatures of the full name, the nature of the occupation and residence of each member of the same, and further, a bank deposit receipt for the sum of \$1,000 must accompany the tender for the works.

The respective deposit receipts—cheques will not be accepted—must be endorsed over to the Minister of Railways and Canals, and will be forfeited if the party tendering do lines entering into contract for the works at the rates and on the terms stated in the offer submitted. The deposit receipts thus sent in will be returned to the respective parties whose tenders are not accepted.
