

Mohammed Mustafa Miro

Prime Minister of Syria

Born in Al Tal, a suburb of Damascus, in 1941, Mohammed Mustafa Miro earned a doctorate degree in Arabic studies from the University of Damascus.

In 1980, Mr. Miro was appointed Governor of the province of Dara'a, in southern Syria. In 1986, he was nominated Governor of the province of Hasakeh, in northern Syria. From 1993 until his appointment as Prime Minister, he was Governor of Aleppo, Syria's second largest city.

On March 7, 2000, Mr. Miro was appointed Prime Minister of Syria.
