The Universität Stuttgart takes part in the Baden-Württemberg-Ontario exchange program, as described above. But apart from the overall framework of this province to province program, within this program there is also a direct exchange program between the "Fachbereich Ingenieurwissenschaften" of the Universität Stuttgart and the Faculty of Applied Science and Engineering of the University of Toronto. The exchange program between the two departments is for up to three students.

The German participants are selected by a committee of representatives from the university. Canadian students are selected by a similar committee. The participants receive the status of "visiting students" or "non-degree students", which excludes them from obtaining a degree at the host university.

The program includes a preparatory course at the host university and a tuition waiver. Students assume transportation costs and living expenses, although German students can receive an allowance from the Land Baden-Württemberg towards their travel expenses.

The exchange program lasts one year and students in general remain enrolled at their home university. German students usually receive leave status.

This exchange program also covers an exchange for faculty members, although the details have to be arranged individually.
