(A) INTERNATIONAL NEGOTIATIONS AND AGREEMENTS

Agreements concluded or ratified:

- (i) Charter of the United Nations, including the Statute of the International Court of Justice, signed at San Francisco on June 26, 1945: The Canadian Instrument of Ratification of the Charter was deposited with the United States Government at Washington on November 9, 1945.
- (ii) Declaration on Atomic Energy by the President of the United States of America, the Prime Minister of the United Kingdom and the Prime Minister of Canada, signed at Washington, on November 15th, 1945 (See Section (B) 2).
- (iii) Convention modifying the International Maritime Sanitary Convention signed at Paris on June 21, 1926, opened for signature at Washington, on December 15, 1944: The Canadian instrument of Ratification of this Convention was deposited with the United States Government at Washington on November 20, 1945.
- (iv) Convention modifying the International Sanitary Convention for Aerial Navigation signed at The Hague on April 12, 1933, opened for signature at Washington, on December 15, 1944: The Canadian Instrument of Ratification of this Convention was deposited with the United States Government at Washington on November 20, 1945.

Exchange of Notes:

- (i) Ottawa, August 31 and September 6, 1945 - between Canada and the United States of America concerning the disposition of the Canol facilities.
- (ii) Ottawa, June 13 and October 26, 1945 - between Canada and the United States of America constituting an agreement concerning deserters from the armed forces.

(B) PUBLICATIONS

Treaty Series 1945, No. 12: Treaty between Canada and the United States of America for the Extradition of Criminals, signed at Washington on the 29th April, 1942, together with the Protocol annexed thereto signed at Ottawa on the 3rd October, 1945. These instruments have not yet been ratified.

Treaty Series 1945, No. 15: Declaration on Atomic Energy signed by the President of the United States of America, the Prime Minister of the United Kingdom and the Prime Minister of Canada, at Washington on the 15 November 1945.

Diplomatic List with which is included The List of British Commonwealth Representatives and Consuls General in Ottawa, November 1, 1945.

Canadian Representatives abroad and Representatives in Canada of the British Commonwealth and Foreign Governments, List dated October 1, 1945, published November 28.
