APPOINTMENT TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE INTERNATIONAL CENTRE FOR OCEAN DEVELOPMENT

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announced today the appointment of Mary Jo Duncan as a Director of the International Centre for Ocean Development (ICOD).

Ms. Duncan has a Ph.D. in Biology from Simon Fraser University.

Currently, she is a Biology instructor at Fraser Valley College, coordinator of the Association for the Promotion and Advancement of Science Education, and a marine biology researcher. Ms. Duncan is the writer of articles for periodicals and television, and has served as a consultant.

The International Centre for Ocean Development, located in Halifax, Nova Scotia, fosters cooperation between Canada and developing countries in the field of ocean resources development. Since 1983, ICOD has been funded in the form of a grant from the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA).
