

On motion of Mr. Cardiff, seconded by Mr. Hodgson, it was ordered,—That the name of Mr. Small be substituted for that of Mr. MacEwan on the Standing Committee on Railways, Canals and Telegraph Lines.

The Bill No. C-53, An Act to amend the Emergency Gold Mining Assistance Act, was read the third time and passed.

The House resumed consideration in Committee of the Whole of a certain proposed resolution to establish a Board of Broadcast Governors.

*(In the Committee)*

The following resolution was adopted:

Resolved,—That it is expedient to introduce a measure to establish a Board of Broadcast Governors to regulate broadcasting in Canada; to provide that the expenditure of the Board shall be paid out of money appropriated by Parliament therefor and also to provide for the continuance of a corporation known as the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation for the purpose of operating a national broadcasting service in Canada; and to provide further for the payment, remuneration, salaries and fees of the officers and employees thereof.

The said resolution was reported and concurred in.

Mr. Nowlan, seconded by Mr. Fleming (Eglinton), by leave of the House, presented a Bill, No. C-55, An Act respecting Broadcasting, which was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The Order being read for the second reading of Bill No. C-43, An Act to amend the Financial Administration Act;

Mr. Fleming (Eglinton), seconded by Mr. Nowlan, moved,—That the said Bill be now read a second time.

After debate thereon, the question being put on the said motion, it was agreed to.

The said Bill was accordingly read the second time, considered in Committee of the Whole, and reported without amendment.

By unanimous consent, the said Bill was read the third time and passed.

The Order being read for the second reading of Bill No. C-50, An Act to amend the Customs Tariff;

Mr. Fleming (Eglinton), seconded by Mr. Pearkes, moved,—That the said Bill be now read a second time.

After debate thereon, the question being put on the said motion, it was agreed to.

The said Bill was accordingly read the second time, considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, and ordered for a third reading at the next sitting of the House.
