Ament of municipal council or Railway Committee.

(2) No such agreement shall be acted upon in any municipality affected thereby until the assent of the municipal council of the said municipality shall have been ebtained thereto, or until an order has been made by the Railway Committee pursuant to the previsions of this Act.

Application to Railway Com- re' mittee where mnnicipality

If any municipality affected by such agreement shall 'o assent thereto, an application may be made by either y to the Railway Committee for leave to act upon the greement, notwithstanding the want of such assent, and pon such application being made the Railway Committee may appoint a cate for the hearing of the application and notice shall be sent by post to the parties to the said agreement and to the nen-assenting municipality.

Objections to be stated and filed.

(4) The Railway Committee in fixing a day or at any time thereafter may require the non-assenting municipality to said agreement in writing and file ith the Secretary of the Railway specify its objections to a cepy of such objecti Committee, and to serve a copy thereof upon the parties to the said agreement.

(5) The Railway Committee may appoint or direct any Inquiry and report for person to make an inquiry or report upon any such agreement, person to make an inquiry or report upon any such agreement, or any other matter or thing connected therewith or incident te the objections raised by any non-assenting municipality.

(6) The Railway Committee and any person appointed to Powers of (b) The rankway Committee and Committee as make any inquiry and report may:to inquiry and report.

- (b) Irspect any works, motors, cars, carriages or 11 5 of either company.
- (c) Require the attendance of all such persons as it or he thinks fit to call before it or him, and examine er require answers or returns to such inquiry as it or he thinks fit to make.
- (d) Require the production of books, papers, plans, specifications, proofs and documents relating to the matters before it or him.

Witnesses and evidence before commit-

(7) The Railway Committee shall have the same power to enforce the attendance of witnesses and to compel them to give evidence and produce books, papers or things which they are required to produce as is vested in the High Court of Justice.

Witness fees.

(8) Every witness shall be entitled to receive the same fees and allowances as if summoned to attend before the High Ceurt of Justice.

Matters to be decided on application.

(9) The Railway Committee shall have power to determine all questions arising upon the application of any electric railway company, including:
