change took place. At the end of the novena, Maxime was restored to perfect health, the light of intelligence once more beamed in his eye. When the happy day of his "first Communion" arrived, it is needless to say with what fervor, holy joy and profound gratitude he approached the altar, having Mary Immaculate for his guide.

This cure took place in 1863; he is now fourteen years of age, and has ever since enjoyed perfect health. He is now studying at the College of Carsonne.
