ARCHDEACON MARSH DEAD

Aged Anglican Divine Passes Away after a Prolonged Illness.

Archdeacon Marsh died at his home, 427 Horton street, last night, after a long illness. For some time past he was unable to sit up in bed, and his condition was not thought to be critical until yesterday afternoon about 2:30 o'clock, when he was taken suddenly very ill with an attack of paralysis, thought to have been caused from the bursting of a blood vessel in his head. From the time of the attack until his death he never regained consciousness.

Deceased was born in London, England, and came to this country with a young man, in company with his mother and family.

His first charge in the Church of England, was as rector at Ingersoll, where he remained until 1857, when he was appointed secretary treasurer of the present diocese, upon its being made independent of the diocese of Toronto. At the death of the late Archdeacon Brough he was chosen to fill the office of Archdeacon of London and rector of St. John's, of London town-ship.

Some time ago he retired on account of ill-health, and he has been living in this city up to the time of his death. He was 90 years of age, and is survived by his fourth wife, three sons, George and Walter, of Toronto, and Bertie, at home, and six daughters, Mrs. M. A. Gilbert, Mrs. A. Savage, of Montreal; Elizabeth and Francis, of Toronto, and May and Elma at home.

LONDON CLUBS AND NEW LIQUOR ACT

Hon. Mr. Hanna Interviewed on the Subject—Those Whom Law Affects.

Hon. W. J. Hanna, provincial secretary, spent last night in this city, and this morning left for Toronto. His business here was of a private nature.

While in the city he was interviewed by Mr. J. H. Flock, representing the London Club, in regard to the effect the new act will have on local clubs.

Speaking of the London Club and the Travelers' Club, Mr. Hanna is reported to have said:

"There is a class of club which will be affected by the new legislation, and I do not doubt that London has its share. But I do not think that the two clubs at present concerned need have any fear, because they appear to be clubs in the best sense of the term."

Mr. Hanna advised both clubs to put their statements in writing and submit them to the department at Toronto, when they will be advised as to the application of the act in their particular cases.

The law was framed, Mr. Hanna says, to wipe out a certain class of club, which leads young men astray. Each club must be chartered, and must pay \$50 annually to the Province. Only such licensed clubs may sell liquor to their members.

At the last election in this city, the statement was made by temperance workers that there are 33 clubs in London which supply liquor to members. If the statement be correct, quite a large number of Londoners will be affected by the new act.

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
