## Y.M.C.A. CONVENTION IN FREDERICTON OPENS

Large Attendance—The Opening Addresses—The Fredericton Wharves

Fredericton, Oct. 22—What gives promise of being the most successful convention ever held by the Maritime Young Men's Christian Association opened in St. Paul's church this evening. Despite the inclement weather there was a large attendance and the proceedings were followed with much interest. Capt. J. E. Masters, of Moncton, presided and Rev. Geo. Wood, of Chatham, conducted a very enjoyable service of song, in which the Antioch Quartette took part.

Rev. W. A. McKinnon, of Halifax, delivered the address on Present Needs in relation to young men in the provinces. At the outset he deplored the exodus of young men to the United States and the west and argued that their services were badly needed at home. Every effort, he said, should be made to improve upon the people the need of adopting an aggressive citizenship which will result in the development of our great natural resources. He praised the natural scenery of the maritime provinces and declared that it compared favorably with that of any country in the world. He said that the young men of our province must have faith in our province; we must not be narrow. The maritime provinces are bound to be an important factor in the country and there is no reason why our young men should go abroad to earn a livelihood. The speaker claimed that the Y. M. C. A. was rendering good service by giving young men larger ideas of their own province. He dwelt upon the importance of Christian men interesting themselves in the politics of the country and he felt it was their duty to endeavor as far as possible to offset the evil influence of the grater, who frequently dominates party conventions. Our politics, said he, needs to be redeemed from unholy influences and it is incumbent upon us to assert ourselves. The speaker had a good word to say concerning athletic sports, but was very severe on those who indulge in gambling. In closing, he alluded to the influence of the liquor traffic and hoped the day would come when it would be stamped out. Capt. J. T. Masters spoke entertainingly of the needs of the Y. M. C. A. work in the maritime provinces. The field, he declared, was a difficult one, and the most urgent need at the present time was more men and more money. At the close of the meeting the student delegates were pleasantly entertained in the Auld Kirk by the Y. M. C. A.

ADVICE TO BLIND

Boston, Oct. 22—Ask no quarter and ask no favor," was the advice which United States Senator Thomas P. Gore, the blind statesman of Oklahoma, gave to the pupils at the Perkins Institution for the Blind in South Boston, in an address which he delivered at the school today. "When you go out into the world," he said, "you will find that the struggle for existence is fierce. Qualify yourselves for this battle, fight it honorably. If handicapped, any of you should chance to be, winning with this handicap, it will enhance your glory."

Berlin, Oct. 22—Princess Victoria Louise was today appointed a colonel in the famous second Hussar guard regiment stationed at Dantzig. Emperor William presented his daughter to the higher officers of the regiment on the grounds of the new palace at Potsdam. The young colonel was mounted and wore the regimental uniform. She looked her smartest in her frocked Hussar jacket and dolman which was richly trimmed with black astrakhan and silver lace. Her bushy hair in front the grim skull and cross bones shaped in silver.
