The Secretary laid on the table a statement of the Contingent Fund of the Synod.

The Chairman appointed Mr. R. T. Clinch a Committee to audit the same.

On motion the Synod adjourned till 3 P. M.

The Synod resumed work at 3 P. M., the Bishop Coadjutor having stated that the Bishop was unable to attend the meeting for a short time, and had requested him to take the chair, in order to expedite business.

Rev. Canon Brigstocke presented and read a Report from the Committee on a Uniformity of Registration.

Mr. R. T. Clinch reported that he had examined the statement of the Secretary on account of the Contingent Fund, and found it correct, with the necessary vouchers.

Mr. W. M. Jarvis stated that in consequence of the withdrawal of the Bill presented to the Legislature at its last Session, the work of the Committee on the Codification of the Constitution and Canons was withheld.
