## GREB VICTORY SPUR TO GAME

Fans Expect Him to Keep  
Up Habit of Frequent  
Milling.

(New York Tribune.)

A stimulus is expected in the ranks of middleweights, now that Harry Greb holds the title. Greb himself is a tireless ring worker—tireless in action in individual bouts and tireless, too, in the number of bouts in which he has been his custom to engage. It is hoped that Greb will continue his habit of boxing often. If he does he will be a different champion from Wilson. The title he has just won has been practically non-existent for two years. Like the featherweight championship which Johnny Kilbane preserved until the fatal meeting with Crigoli, the middleweight title has been, to all intents and purposes, out of competition.

Possibly with Greb as champion and defending his title against all comers who qualify, this particular division of boxing will experience a stimulus which will lift it from the semi-obscurity to which it has fallen. Explaining the present sad plight of the middleweight class is difficult, but there is no gaining that lack of incentive has been one of the primary causes for the condition of mediocrity which surrounds

This division of pugilism today. It rests with Greb to revive interest in this class and make it what it has been in the past and what it should be—one of the most popular of boxing's eight classes. Greb can be instrumental in bringing about this desirable end through being "a fighting champion."

The bout in which Greb won his title was of itself the greatest indication of the sad condition of the middleweight ranks. Greb won his title from a mediocre boxer who held the championship for so long only because he was under suspension and could not defend the honor. Wilson was not even remotely comparable to others who have been leaders in this ring division. As a matter of fact, Greb is not much of an improvement, when it is remembered that among the middleweight champions of the past were Bob Fitzsimmons, Tommy Ryan and Stanley Ketchel. Nevertheless Greb is an improvement and that is encouraging. He must improve his style of boxing, however, if he is to gain that distinction and popularity associated with middleweight champions of the past. This improvement in Greb must amount practically to a complete change of his style, too. His only attributes just now are speed and tireless energy. There is little to recommend the new champion. He violates accepted rules of boxing in every bout, unintentionally, if the charitable view is taken, but he commits the violations nevertheless. Greb repeatedly was warned for violations last Friday night. He held and hit, hit on the breakaway and was interrupted several times in

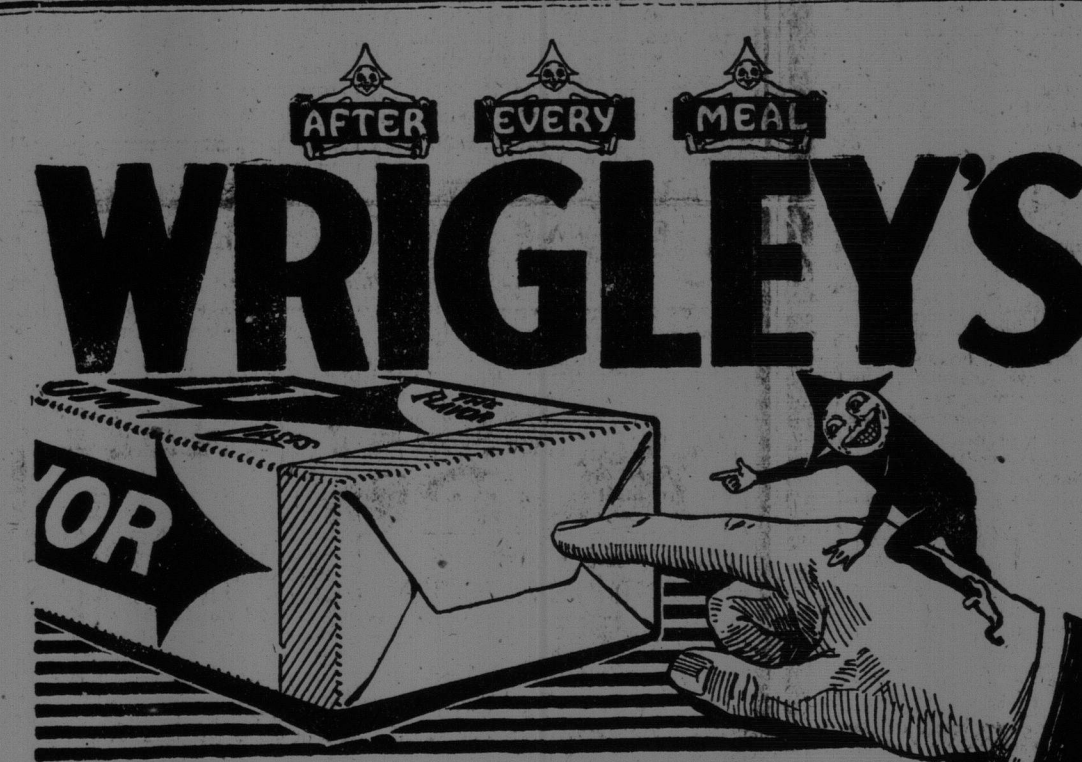
