Sir,

In view of an application to be shortly made from the Indians, belonging to the St. Peters Indian Reserve, situate on the Red River in the Province of Manitoba, and also from those at West Alexander, east side of Lake Winnipeg, to the Government to have their lands within their respective Reserves, surveyed, and subdivided into allotments of land each family, or single individual, entitled in conformity with the Indian Treaty of 1870, and mentioned in the Manitoba Indian Act, which provides that each member of a family thirty two acres of land, and five of a family one hundred and sixty.

I should respectfully ask your Hon. order the same recommendations as heretofore to be made to obtain for me either of the above surveys, and that my application should be granted by your Dept.
