the St. Peters Indian Reserve, situated on the Red River
in the Province of Manitoba, and also from those
at Fort Alexander, east side of Lake Winnipegosis,
for the Government to have their lands within their re-
serves, surveyed, and subdivided into allotments
suit each family, or single individual, entitled
in conformity with the Indian Treaty of 1870.
mentioned in the Manitoba Indian Act. Which
each member of a family thirty two acres of land
five of a family one hundred and sixty.

I would respectfully ask your Honor
under the same recommendations as heretofore to
so obtain for me either of the above survey
application should be granted by your Dept.
