In view of an application to be shortly made from the Indians, belonging to the St. Peters Indian Reserve, situate on the Red River in the Province of Manitoba, and also from those at Fort Alexander, east side of Lake Winnipeg, to the Government to have their lands within their respective Reserves, surveyed, and subdivided into allotments, suit each family, or single individual, entitled in conformity with the Indian Treaty of 1870, as mentioned in the Manitoba Indian Act. Which each member of a family thirty two acres of land, five of a family one hundred and sixty.

I should respectfully ask your Hon. order the same recommendations as heretofore to be obtained for me either of the above survey application should be sent by your Dep.
