NEW COMPANIES FEWER LAST YEAR

Ottawa, Ont., July 6.—The financial stringency is having market effect upon the incorporation of companies in Canada. In the last fiscal year there was a decrease of 182 in the number of incorporations and of \$91,922 in the departmental revenue from that source. There was, however, a healthy business in company development.

During the fiscal year the number of companies chartered was 758 with a total capitalization of \$425,307,569. The revenue from this source was \$212,729. In the previous year 925 hew companies were chartered with an aggregate capital of \$680,762,199 and the revenue was \$304,652.
