Sir,

I have the honour to enclose herewith Voucher No. 355, in favour of R. P. Spies, Lloydminster, Sask., for \$ 152.88, for repairs to the hot water tank at the Union Lake Roman Catholic Indian Residential School here.

This work has cost more than at first estimated, for the reason that when the manhole was out in the tank so that an examination could be made, it was found that the coils, eleven in number, were so completely corroded as to make repairs impossible, and it was therefore necessary to purchase all new material for these.

I may add that a very satisfactory job has been made, and the principal of the school has expressed himself as being very pleased with it.
