CHAPTER 4.

An Act respecting the Salaries of certain Public Functionaries and other annual charges on the Consolidated Revenue.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Sums mentioned in this Act, to be payable without an annual vote.

1. There shall be payable yearly, and pro ratâ for any less period than a year, the salaries and sums of money mentioned in the following sections of this Act, to the persons and for the purposes therein specified, and the same shall be payable out of any unappropriated moneys forming part of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Canada. 31 V., c. 33, s. 2.
