His Majesty, by Warrant under His Royal Sign Manual, may, at any Time before 5 Jan. 1750, authorize the Commissioners of the Treatury to raise the faid Sum, either by Loans, or Exchequer Bills;

in the fame Manner as is preferibed, concerning Loans or Exchequer Bills, by the Malt Act of this Seilion.

All Clauses, Provisoes, and Powers, &c. in the said Act, relating to Loans and Exchequer Bills, extended to this Act.

Exception.

The Money fo raised, to be repaid out of the First Supplies;

most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Confent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same. That it shall and may be lawful to and for the King's most Excellent Wajesty, by Warrant of Marrants under his Royal Sign Manual, to authorize and impower the Commissioners of his Wajesty's Treasury now of for the time being, of any Three of more of them, or the Lord High Treasurer for the time being, at any Time or Times before the Fifth Day of January, Dne thousand seven hundred and fifty nine, to cause or direct any Loans to be taken of received at His Maiello's Erchequer, from any Person of Persons, Matives or Kozeigners, Body or Bodies Politick or Corvorate. or any Rumber of Erchequer Bills to be made out there. for any Sum or Sums of Money, not erceeding, in Loans and Erchequer Bills together, in the Whole, the said Sum of Eight hundled thousand Pounds; in the same or like Manner, Form, and Diver, and according to the same or like Rules and Directions, as in and by an Act of this viesent Session of Parliament, intituled. An Act for continuing and granting to His Majesty certain Duties upon Malt, Mum, Cyder, and Perry, for the Service of the Year One thousand seven hundred and fifty eight; are enacted and prescribed, concerning the Loans or Erchequer Bills to be taken or made in pursuance of the faid Ad.

And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid. That all and every the Clauses, Provides, Powers, Privileges. Advantages. Penalties, Forfeitures, and Disabilities, contained in the said last-mentioned Act, relating to the Loans of Erchequer Bills authorized to be made by the same Ad (ercept such Clauses as do charge the same on the Taxes granted by the same Ad) Hall be applied and extended to the Loans and Exchequer Bills to be made in pursuance of this Act, as fully and effectually, to all Intents and Purpoles, as if the same Loans of Exchequer Bills had been originally authorized by the faid last-mentioned Ad, or as if the said several Clauses of Provides had been particularly repeated and re-enacted in the Body of this Ad.

And he it further enacted by the Authority alorelaid, That all such Loans or Exchequer Bills, together with the Interest, Premium, Rate, and Tharges, incident to, or attending the same, shall be, and are hereby charged and chargeable upon, and shall be repaid or borne by or out of the First Aids or Supplies which shall be granted in the next Session of Parliament; and in case sufficient by
