## An Act supplementary to the Common School Act for Upper Canada.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make some further provision Preamble. for the improvement of Common Schools in Upper Canada, and to modify and extend some of the provisions of the Act passed in the session held in the thirteenth and fourteenth years 5 of Her Majesty's Reign, chaptered forty-eight, and intituled, An Act for the better establishment and maintenance of Common 13 & 14 Vict. Schools in Upper Canada, hereinafter called "the Upper Canada c. 48. School Act of 1850 ": Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's

Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of 10 the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, An Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and
