

An Act to amend Chapter 75 of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada intituled: An Act respecting Master and Servant.

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the application, in certain cases, of the provisions of the Act respecting Master and Servant, Chapter 75 of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, and it is expedient that they should be removed: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. If after the termination of an engagement between Master and Servant, any dispute shall arise between them in respect of the terms of such engagement or of any matter appertaining to it, the Justice or Justices of the Peace who shall receive the complaint shall be bound to decide the matter in accordance with the provisions of the Act respecting Master and Servant, and as though the engagement between the parties still subsisted; Provided that proceedings be taken within one month after the engagement shall have ceased.
