

An Act respecting the Montfort and Gatineau  
Colonization Railway Company.

**WHEREAS** the Montfort and Gatineau Colonization Rail- Preamble.  
way Company has by its petition prayed that it be  
enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant  
the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and  
5 with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of  
Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

**1.** The Montfort and Gatineau Colonization Railway Com- Extension

pany, hereinafter called “the Company,” may extend its line  
of railway from its present terminus near St. Sauveur to a point  
10 on the line of the Great Northern Railway Company near St.  
Canut, in the county of Two Mountains, and thence to a junc-  
tion with the line of the Jacques Cartier Union Railway Com-  
pany in the county of Jacques Cartier near the city of Montreal.

**2.** The Company may issue bonds, debentures or other Bond issue.  
15 securities to the extent of twenty thousand dollars per mile of  
the extension of its line hereby authorized.

**3.** Section 9 of chapter 75 of the statutes of 1898 is amended 1898, c. 75,  
s. 9 amended  
by inserting after the word “Company” in the second line the  
words “the Grand Trunk Railway Company of Canada, the  
20 Jacques Cartier Union Railway Company.”
