WHEREAS Order in Council P.C. 2/1437, dated the 11th day of April, 1946, authorized the purchase of the lands in the Province of Alberta described in the attached schedule, for the Stony Band of Indians of Alberta;

chased and title is now in His Majesty the King in the Right of Canada;

AND WHEREAS the Director of Indian Affairs has recommended that the said lands be set apart for the use of the Stony Band of Indians of Alberta;

General in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister of Mines and Resources, is pleased to order that the lands described in the attached schedule be and they are hereby set apart for the use and benefit of the Stony Band of Indians of Alberta and that the said lands shall be additions to Stony Indian Reserve Nos. 142, 143 and 144, Alberta.
