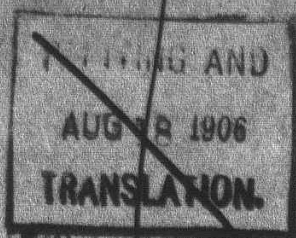

I have the honour to say that I have followed your instructions regarding the difficulty for the right of way between Charles Boncher and Indians.

I have written to both Boncher and Indians of Les Communes and a few Indians came to see me since and say that I should go up to Les Communes to settle that question and at the same time see the river constructed to drain waters of the Indian Reserve and other lands.

If the Department wishes that I should go to Les Communes, please advise me.
