I have the honor to submit my Report on this Agency for the month of January 1895. as follows.

During the month I have been engaged in visiting the several Nations under my supervision and in attending to the supplying of supplies to Montreal Lake House.

And in visiting Day boarding Schools, as well as the routine work of this Office, which was considerable owing to this being our half yearly return.

Cattle are not branded with the exception of those lately purchased and which I do not feel disposed to brand during the cold weather but all will be completed by summer. All Cattle were staked on this reserve from the 1st of June. The Stakes are all in good order and are kept clean & warm. And in nearly all cases are fitted with stanchions. The distance to water
