Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of July 21st and am very pleased to learn you will arrange to be present at the Demonstration at Erie Beach Fort Erie on 30th inst.

I have enclosed a poster giving full particulars as to the proceedings etc. I might say we held the printing of the posters back as Mr Borden promised Mr German some time ago to send on the names of two Cabinet Ministers who would represent the Government, but so far we have not received the names. As soon as we do we will most likely get out another poster giving the full list of Speakers. I might also say we are waiting on the names of two Cabinet Ministers from Washington.

The proceedings will start at 10 oclock in the morning, and the speeches will come on about two oclock or as soon after as possible.

Dinner to the Speakers and guests is being arranged for 6.30 or 7 oclock in the Erie Beach Hotel.

Kindly let me know what train you will come by and we will have a car at Bridgeburg Station to meet you.

Anyone going on to Buffalo can cross over to Erie Beach by the boat from foot of Main Street, or by the Ferry at foot of Ferry Street.

For Speakers or guests coming in the morning we are arranging a luncheon in the Erie Beach Hotel.
