My telegram of August 6th.

The Acting British High Commissioner now reports that the question of Egypt's application to the League of Nations has been dropped. He also reports that since their accession to power attitude of the Government has ~~so far~~ been friendly and correct; and that Zaghoul's behaviour has so far been unexceptionable; indeed, Prime Minister has assured the Acting High Commissioner that Zaghoul is making a sincere effort to win the goodwill of H.M. Government.

There are therefore grounds for hoping that the remaining month of the Session may pass without any serious incidents arising.

Please inform your Prime Minister.
