In further reference to your enquiry as to Lot 35 on the Buctouche Reserve, I beg to say that a thorough search has been made among the records of the Department and no Grant or other document showing transfer of title from Fabian Daigle, or his heirs, to James Daigle can be found.

The only document which was filed at the time that sale was made to James Daigle was Transfer from the Indians to Fabiang A. Daigle, a copy of which a is enclosed.

The statement referred to in previous communication was one made by G.A.Giouard, N.P., in October 1881 and the entry therein regarding this Lot is as follows- " No of Lot 35, No of acres 157, name of occu-

- " pant David Daigle, amount paid by occupant \$57.00, by
- " whom paid per self and H.Budd, deed produced Deed No
- " 14, remarks Grant in James Daigle's name."
