No. 61. Text of Proclamation, Begins:

By The King.

A Proclamation specifying the articles to be treated as contraband of war,

George R.I.

Whereas a state of war exists between us, on the one hand, and Germany on the other:

And whereas it is necessary to specify articles which it is our intention to treat as contraband of war:

Now therefore we do hereby declare, by and with the advice of our Privy Council, that during continuance of war, or until We do give further public notice, the articles enumerated in schedule I hereto will be treated as absolute contraband, and the articles enumerated in schedule II hereto will be treated as conditional contraband:
