Dear Mr. MacKay: Re: Checkwelp I.R.No.26,  
Water Supply

With reference to the proposed re-  
location of storage tank and pipeline in the  
water supply system serving the above reserve,  
you will recall our writing you on August 16,  
wherein it was indicated that any feasible  
route for the pipeline satisfactory to Mr.  
Ball should be acceptable. At that time we  
asked that he indicate his proposals and secure  
the necessary easements, following which the  
work would be undertaken.

We do not appear to have received a  
reply from you to this communication.

Several letters have been received  
from Mr. Mills urging that the work be carried  
to completion at as early a date as possible,  
the latest of which, dated November 15, states  
it is the desire of your branch to have the  
tank removed and certain repairs effected this  
Fall. Will you please arrange to have Mr. Ball  
secure the necessary easements, following which  
the work will be done.
