


THE FIRST NATIVE-BORN CANADIAN TO ENTER THE IMPERIAL SERVICE.

Captain Alexander Maenab, United Empire Loyalist, 2nd Batt., 30th Regt., Special A.D.C. to Sir Thomas Picton.

Captain Maenab left Toronto in 1800, and after serving with distinction throughout the Peninsular campaign, fell in action at the Battle of Waterloo, June 18th, 1815.
